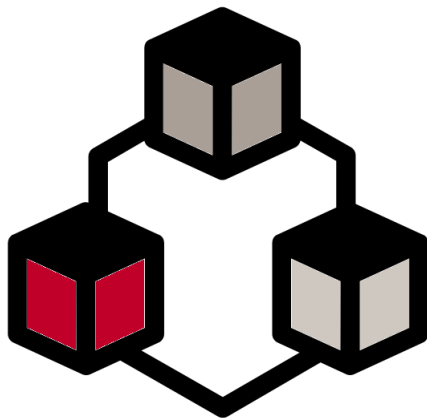


## The Employment and Labour Research Centre(CEET)



The Employment and Labour Research Centre (*Centre d'Etudes de l'Emploi et du Travail*, CEET), has been created on the 1st of October 2016 following the integration of the *Centre d'Etudes de l'Emploi* to the Conservatoire national des arts et métiers (Cnam, Paris). **The Employment and Labour Research Centre aims at developing pluridisciplinary research on labour and employment issues.**

Its research topics include labour market inequalities (gender, origin...), employment and labour public policies, life course and labour trajectories, organizational change in relationship with technology.
